



Election Rule Book

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Version 1.0 | Effective 2026

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SECTION 1

1. ELECTION COMMISSION & AUTHORITY

1.1 All elections within the AIDMJCCA shall be conducted by an independent **National Election Commission (NEC)** constituted by the National Executive Council.

1.2 The Commission shall consist of a Chief Election Officer (CEO) and two Election Observers who hold no executive candidacy in the upcoming election.

1.3 The decision of the National Election Commission regarding candidate eligibility, voting integrity, and election disputes shall be final and binding.

SECTION 2

2. VOTER & CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Only active, verified, and dues-cleared members holding minimum tenure requirements shall have the right to cast votes or file nominations.

2.2 Eligibility Matrix by Office Tier

SECTION 3

3. CODE OF ELECTION CONDUCT

3.1 No candidate shall indulge in negative campaigning, hate speech, defamation, communal polarization, or paid promotional propaganda.



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3.2 Canvassing via digital channels must strictly cease 24 hours prior to the commencement of online/offline polling.

3.3 Bribery, coercion, offering gifts, or misrepresenting official association branding will lead to automatic disqualification.

DISQUALIFICATION NOTICE



Any candidate found violating election bylaws, submitting forged credentials, or tampering with electronic voting tokens will face immediate candidacy cancellation and a 3-year ban from internal elections.

SECTION 4

4. ELECTION TIMELINE & VOTING MECHANISM

4.1 The Election Commission shall issue an official gazette notification defining the schedule for nomination, scrutiny, withdrawal, and polling date.

4.2 Digital voting shall occur via encrypted OTP-verified ballots directly through the secure Member Portal.

4.3 Results shall be counted publicly by the Chief Election Officer and certified by the Governing Body.
